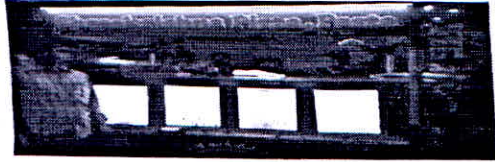
Conclusion
