

'Development Experiences of India, China, Brazil and South Africa'

Report

On 22nd and 24thJan, 2018, Ms. Arundhati Agate delivered lectures on the "Development Experiences of India and China" and on the "Development Experiences of South Africa and Brazil" respectively to the TYBA students of Economics in room no 110 and in the A. V. Room.



She thoroughly touched all the aspects of the economic development in these four countries. She talked about the current economic conditions in India, China, South Africa and Brazil, the major economic problems like inflation in Brazil, Health-related issues in South Africa, Ageing problem in China, etc. faced by these countries, the economic strengths of these countries and challenges for future economic growth. The session was interactive and

was beneficial for all the students. She provided an overview of the Chinese economy and highlighted the fact that China was a Manufacturing economy with the world's largest population making it the fastest growing consumer market. It has a one party communist party regime as against India which has witnessed multi-party politics and coalition governments of late. It appears that the one party rule in China, although impinging on peoples' freedoms has delivered a better economic performance of the economy.

Ms Agte described the awakening of China under three regimes, viz. those of Mao, Deng and Post Deng. She drew parallels and made comparisons between the Indian economy and the Chinese one with respect to diverse areas which included agricultural, industrial and educational reforms, population growth, family planning, female labour participation rate, migration, SEZ model of industrialisation, R & D, Education and Sports.





Ms Agte also gave the students an insight into the challenges ahead of the dragon. These included higher labour costs, inflation, an aging population, higher foreign debt (Debt to GDP ratio is 300%), environmental problems (associated with greater industrialisation and greater carbon emissions) slowdown of Chinese exports and rising income inequalities.

The lecture was well received by the students. The concluding part of the session was interactive with the students posing pertinent question on prospects, challenges and lessons to be learnt from China's growth story.

The Department of Accountancy, Costing Students of S.Y.B.Com visited to Pravin Masalewale, Yawat Plant on 20/12/17, a Company that manufactures under the Brand names Ambaari and Suhana masala powders and ready to cook masalas.

The students were welcomed by Mr. Abhijeet Basargaonkar, Executive Secretary to Director, after a short tea break; the student were given certain guidelines to be followed in the factory premises, one of which was prohibition of photography in the restricted areas of the factory. They were then, taken to the Waste Management Learning Centre for a briefing about the Corporate History of the Company.

The Managers of Manufacture Processing, Costing, Time Office Management, IT Department and HR Department addressed them with the help of an informative Presentation followed by a Question & Answer Session.

It covered a practical perspective of how an Organization works:-

Requirements of the 3Ms: Material, Man Power and Machine; The Hierarchy of the Organization; The combined use of Manual Recording of Attendance and Electronic Access Control; The Importance of Punctuality of Workers and consequences on failure of compliance; The Salary Structure: calculated on a Monthly basis or on a Daily basis; The Company's emphasis on Quality over Quantity of their products; The Use of ERP Package that combines all the modules of each and every department into one integrated software: commonly used right from Marketing, Production, Stores, Finance and Human Resources Department thus providing Relevant Information on Real Time Basis; Quality Checks at every stage of production of the product and many other topics.

The students were satisfied with answers the executives provided and were encouraged to address their queries.

The Head of Inventory Store gave them practical insight on determining Material Requirement of a Product, Issuing Purchase Order, Material Quality Inspection System Red-White-Green colour coding, Inventory of Materials to be used for Production and Making sure the rate of normal loss of Raw Material is low (approx. 20%).

The Students were able correlate the theoretical concepts they had studied with the practices being carried out by the Company, for instance, the Yearly Sales Budgets of the Company being further broken down into monthly targets which was cumulative of daily goals to be fulfilled by the production.

Further the process of how Masala powder is manufactured was explained to them prior to their tour in the factory and that enabled them to understand the process clearly. They were asked to wear masks and hair nets to comply with the hygiene standards the factory strictly adhered to.

They were shown the Raw Material Storage, Mixing, Frying, Grading, and Packaging Departments. They were fortunate to see the RTC Section where Ready to Cook Masalas were manufactured. They observed how the semi-finished goods were transported to the warehouse and later on transported to the packaging departed after which it was loaded onto trucks to go to the CFA(Carrying and Forwarding Agents) Warehouses.

After the Factory tour, the Head of the Time Records Department explained to the students, how the company uses Biometrics in the form of Thumb Impression Scanners to record the in and out time for the salaried employees

Punch cards were used where the time of their arrival and departure is recorded on the punch cards for Contract workers. This activity was to be supervised to avoid manipulation of records.

The Company still maintains a master muster for all its employees. The Company trains their contract workers how to operate their machines and emphasize on maintaining hygiene standards on the shop floor.

The workers were paid either on an Hourly basis or on Piece Rate Method based on whether the work done. For instance the Packing Department pays its employees based on Piece Rate while the Grinding Unit was paid on the basis of Hourly Wage Rate. The Company has 3 shifts of on an average of 8.5 hours including half an hour lunch break and the workers have to report to their stations 15 minutes prior to their shift.

The Students had an opportunity to see the factory workers go for their lunch break at 12 pm upon the prompt sound of the siren. This indicated the discipline in the organization.

The Company followed FIFO method of Inventory Stock Taking and has over the years automated some of its processes resulting in lower Labour cost and time taken. For instance, dispatching finished goods in one truck is now done by one man using a forklift; the same work required 12 men and time period of 45 minutes to load one truck. The Raw Materials to be used in production were stored right above the workshop floor where, with use of gravity, they would slide the Raw Material down a slide, as in when required, but keeping in mind the safety of the workers, they use a siren to signal the workers to move away from the shop floor when this process takes place.

The Company also uses weighting machines that automatically rejects empty masala boxes and makes sure the contents do not go below the tolerance level; Large Magnets are used to separate the masala from any metallic impurities. They conduct Quality Checks for moisture, chemical composition, grading material and impurities at every stage of production, and masala are tested for their taste and quality by using them for cooking food in the factory kitchens itself.

The Students were done with our factory tour by 12:40 pm after which they were served sumptuous "Misal Pav" and "Sheera" for Lunch. The food was cooked using the vegetables grown in the organic farm and the masala produced by the factory.

After Lunch, Prof. Dimple Buche gave a Vote of Thanks to the Company, followed by the feedback given by few students on what they have learnt from the Industrial Visit and how it has given them a practical approach to the Theoretical Knowledge they have learnt so far and have thoroughly enjoyed the experience.

Prof Merchant introduced the Whabiz Merchant Memorial Lecture with a beautiful poem he had dedicated to his sister who was no more. The series consisted of 10 lectures all over the country where the first five were male speakers and the next five would be women. Thus St Mira's kicked of the second leg of the series.

Suniti Namjoshi a renowned writer from the UK is an ex IAS officer who did her PhD on Ezra Pound. She read several of her stories and poems which were delightful, humorous and yet profound. She talked about how the myths mutated over time and focussed on feminist reworking of some ancient myths like those from the Panchatantra, Aesop Fables and some ancient Greek myths.

The lecture was recorded and uploaded on youtube for all to see.

2.3.1-Experiential Learning and Particpative Learning







On 2nd December 2017 a guest lecture titled, "Strategic Marketing Planning and Advertising Research" was delivered by Mrs. Sharmila Sathe to F.Y.B.Com Marketing, S.Y.B.Com Marketing and T.Y.B.Com Business Administration-III and Marketing- II students. A total of 58 students attended the session.

She explained how emotions play an important role in advertising thus connecting the product to the audience. The speaker focused on advertising research and marketing planning. Different kind of media and their pros and cons were put down statistically. She emphasised the importance of choosing the right media on the basis of its reach and influence. She justified it by quoting influence percentage of different media like TV (40.4%), Digital media (33.3%), newspaper (9%), magazines (6%), outdoor media (5.8%), and lastly radio as (4.3%). She unveiled the true story behind many commercials and their making strategy so that students are given a glimpse of hardwork, dedication and uniqueness one needs to attain.

She also elaborated about brand research advertisement research and parameters of evaluation like comprehension, relevance likes/ dislikes, interest generated, imagery associated, etc.

The students had an interactive session with her and were given a chance to personally ask her about the process, opportunities and challenges in the field and its diversity.





The aim of the workshop was to introduce the idea and importance of business plan and provide hands on experience through exercises and discussion on the same.


