Scriptwriting Workshop at St Mira's on Sunday 9th August 2020 from 10am onwards.

St Mira's College for Girls, conducted a 4 hours virtual scriptwriting workshop open to everyone on Sunday 9th August, 2020 from 10 am onward with Aditya Kripalani who held his audience spell bound for the entire time.

Aditya Kripalani, an Indian filmmaker, writer, musician and producer made his directorial debut with the award winning film *Tikli and Laxmi Bomb* (2017). He went on to make films like *Totta Pataaka Item Maal* and *Devi Aur Hero* which received international acclaim because of the powerful social issues they address.

All the way from Singapore, Aditya took time out to cover key points in scriptwriting starting with the fundamental issue, "Why do we write?" He felt writing is a form of wish fulfillment, differentiated between a plot driven movie as opposed to a character centric one, appreciated inner conflict over outer conflict, explained the 3 Act structure of setting up the problem, confronting it and craftfully resolving it and Lajos Egri's character bone structure which fleshes out the physical, social and psychological factors that make up character. The session was wonderfully interactive and ended with an exciting discussion on his movies, becoming a writer and believing in one's craft.







Activity Report-Dept of English Clubs 2020-21

The Department of English has been hosting, for the past three years, 6 Clubs managed by a minimum of 3 student coordinators each and 1 staff member. This year saw the introduction of a new writing club that was informal and focussed on current events called The Mira Press. The Clubs aim to empower students from the entire college to follow and independently manage their extracurricular passions, transforming textbook learning into lived experience where students participate, manage, organise and problem shoot. The 6 Clubs for the students and by the students are

1. The Litwits and JNK- The LitWits Club of the Department of English hosted its Introductory Session for the academic year 2020 - 21 on the 28 th of July 2020 on Zoom at 2:00 PM. The session was open to all the students of the college and was attended by a group of 26 enthusiastic girls, including a few alumni. The session was highly interactive with ice-breaking activities like Name Acrostics, Fun Facts about Myself, discussions on students' favourite characters, books, TV shows, fandoms and accounts of personal achievements. The session also included a video screening of all the activities of the LitWits from the past and welcomed suggestions for activities of interest for the future. The sessions not only enabled the members to get to know each other more but also allowed them a space for informal social interaction which the pandemic has denied them for a long time. After the orientation held on the 25 th of July, the members of LitWits and JNK spent time planning sessions that would be feasible to conduct online that fellow students would be able to connect with. This resulted in a month-long virtual celebration of art which began with JNK's session on the 21 st of August 2020 where everyone was invited for a screening of K-pop group BTS's new release 'Dynamite'. The new music video was appreciated for its vibrant visuals as well as retro themes which were all conveyed for the first time in English by the South-Korean band. This was followed by a Poetry Appreciation Session on 22 nd August 2020 by the LitWits with enthusiastic participants who shared their original works of poetry which were appreciated and received constructive feedback. The Instagram page of the Club was revived to increase engagement with students which was severely lacking due to the lockdown situation and the lack of face to face communication. The LitWits celebrated stories and poetry in various forms over the month of September. Sessions were held by the club every weekend, beginning with the first session on 5 th September 2020 called "Poetry Appreciation" which invited original works for presentation on the themes of 'Silver', 'Mortality', 'Window' and 'Winter'. The themes were chosen by conducting a poll on the Instagram page. On the 11 th of September, a session called "Reading Sorority" was held in which two students, Harleen Kaur Grewal and Shreya Bhide, read a few chapters from the book


Gone Girl by Gillian Flynn. On the 12 th of September, the September Saga continued with Prose Appreciation in which students presented their original works of prose. On the 16 th of the month, the club held a session on Flash Fiction in which participants were given prompts to write a short story of their own and on the 19 th of September, students got together once more to present original pieces of writing in various forms such as Drabble, Dribble, Sudden Fiction and Flash Fiction. On the 18 th of September, 'Unwinding Fridays' was initiated wherein all members and participants gathered virtually to listen to a specially curated Spotify playlist together to destress. Some students did artwork while others completed assignments as they collectively listened to the playlist. The second 'Unwinding Friday' session was held on the 25 th of the month in which an audio drama called 'The Two Princes' was played on Spotify for everyone to enjoy and relax together. On the 26 th of September, the LitWits organised a two-hour special session on the theme "Death and Resurrection" in which students presented various forms of poetry, prose and flash fiction.

The JNK organised a week-long celebration of "Kawaii and Chibi" from 28th September 2020 to 3rd October 2020 in which members shared their artworks, stickers, GIFs, memes and other creations using a variety of applications. YouTube videos such as "Tutorials to Draw", "How to look Kawaii" and "5 Kawaii Aesthetic Fun Apps You Need" were shared. The session started with introducing the concepts of "Kawaii" and "Chibi" through a historical perspective to the members and ended by showcasing some of the artworks made and shared by the members throughout the week.



IAWS Western Regional Conference Session on Gender, Media and the Pandemic

28th November 2020, Saturday: An online vibrant panel discussion on the role of media on gender construction during and post pandemic, gender citizenship, invisibility and further marginalization of women and many more topics related to the theme was organised by the Indian Association for Women's Studies and facilitated by St. Mira's College for girls Pune through the Zoom app. Some of the eminent panelists who guided this conference were: Dr Meera Velayudhan (President IAWS), Dr Vibhuti Patel (The convener of the session), Pamela Phillipose (Public Editor of Wire.in), Sharmila Kalgutkar (Special correspondent Maharashtra Times), Dr Triveni Goswami Mathur (Fulbright Scholar, Media and Communication Professional), Geeta Seshu (Co-editor, Free Speech collective) and Japleen Pasricha (Founder- Director of Feminism in India).

The session began with the introduction of the institution by Dr Vaishali Diwakar (HOD, Department of Sociology, St. Mira's College for Girls Pune).

The session was then followed by the Convener's address **Dr Vibhuti Patel** who talked about the situation of women during the pandemic, loss of livelihood, reproductive health and how NGO's have started working for intersectional and interregional middle-class bias of working from home etc. It was then followed by the Presidential address by **Dr Meera Velayudhan** who shared her experience of collaboration with the **Gujarat University and the Department of Journalism** where the students arranged an event related to sexual violence.

Dr Vaishali Joshi introduced the panelists and then onwards the session was taken over by **Dr Triveni Goswami Mathur** who being the moderator very authentically gave insight to the important issues and systematically summed up all the highlighted pointers presented during the discussion thus fully moderating the session in a significant way.

PANEL DISCUSSION

1. Pamela Phillipose

Principal Incharge
St. Mira's College for Girls, Pone.



She started her speech by throwing light to 4 major references: gender, media, pandemic and the policies made during the pandemic. According to her Gender differences in the society leads to 3 different phenomena – social disintegration, failure of the policy and economic distress. Regarding media she talked how it has over the time become quite cynical due to structural flaws. There is lack of gender representation which is one of the most prominent reasons behind media being perceived as antagonistic in nature by some. There is more of male centred content with continuous trivialisation, objectification and sensationalisation of women. The media is heading to a ruling party friendly kind of an environment with constant creeping communal bias being showcased by it.

With the pandemic, there has been increasing job precarity. Workforce sector also underwent gender discrimination with women professionals being the first to be fired. Several cases of communal and gender issues rose up in the country.

For instance, a pregnant Muslim woman was denied admission to the hospital due to the fear of the virus being spread after the entire "Jamaat" incident took place in New Delhi. Media is annulling when it comes to 'Freedom of expression'. There are certain tragic flaws of the media as it (a) fails to question the government policies implemented during the lockdown whether it be regarding female migrant workers or the Shramik trains perse, (b) fails to capture the full dimension. For instance, there were many cases of domestic violence across the country which were not registered by the police who referred such cases to be mere misunderstanding between people, (c) online platforms for domestic abuse were reducing, (d) cases of sexual harassment, marital rape and abortion of unwanted pregnancies could not cover much reportage. Another important issue she highlights is of the inadequate understanding of social and economic trends.

Lack of women unemployment has led to a precarious gender gap. Lack of critical scrutiny of government documents/data has strengthened the masculine women narrative. And lastly, she concludes how the state policies are acting as a flaw in response to the pandemic.

2. Japleen Pasricha

Her entire talk revolved around how stories from different parts of the country related to gender and the pandemic were covered by the media? She began by drawing two examples: (a) Telangana Mother who walked 1400km to bring her son from Hyderabad and (b) Jyoti Kumari who cycled from Delhi to Bihar. She poses a vey strong question to the panel: Why do we glorify stories that come out from people's miseries?" All kinds of sacrifices made and bravery showed by women are romanticised to a large extent along with their struggle stories. This behaviour ultimately questions the agency of poverty. Economically backward students are not allowed to attend good schools the reason of which is portrayed being lack of intelligence and hard work of the students. This pandemic affected the reproductive services adversely as it enhanced the fear of infection. There was also a rise in unsafe abortions. She further stressed on the concept of workplace and how its definition had changed entirely due to the pandemic with the new "work from home" being encouraged by most of the organisations. With this forms of non-physical sexual harassment came up taking a new face due to digitalisation. Newer formats of sexual

harassment developed with girls getting digitally abused by their colleagues during an ongoing video call or a meeting. This kind of inappropriate behaviour has now evolved through the digital interface. She concludes her talk by focusing on the future of Feminism in the Post Covid times which will be harboured by a strong anchoring of women in an equitable world.

3. Sharmila Kalgutkar

Her main emphasis during the entire talk was how 'public health' emerged as a social institution during this pandemic but also it has become discriminatory for certain sections of the society including women, transgenders and senior citizens. She highlights the aspect of health and superstition as women began to be looked through superstitious views from certain angles. We saw how women were not allowed to come forward for vaccine trials for COVID. Health and medical services came into prominence and people started becoming more cautious than ever before regarding their health. Media played a crucial role in this case when it came to spread awareness about the virus and the precautions to be taken by the people. Advertisements had an important place when it came to make people more alert and aware about their health and they played an important role in making people realise how we take medical services for granted and that we should now realise that nothing remains more important than our lives.

She pointed out few major forms of gender discrimination during the lockdown:

- (i) The society has witnessed women and her duty as caretakers by risking their own lives during the pandemic. Despite undergoing so much of bad treatment they remained firm in performing their duties while carrying out the household work and other chores. As per the Covid positive, cases women are less but level of stress and depression shown them is high.
- (ii) Sex workers had also lost their livelihood and no new safeguards have been designed for them.
- (iii) Cases of harassment of female patients and nurses also came in the limelight which means women will always be the target of assault and violence and her dignity will continuously be hindered no matter whatever the circumstances are.
- (iv) Also when it came to education, online teaching became the new normal mode of learning for all the students across the country. People in the rural areas preferred boys' education when it came to providing the access to resources.
- (v) Even men have been the victims of the patriarchal violence as being the breadwinners of the family many of them lost their jobs and hence they became the prey of stress and depression.

Finally, she concludes by saying that we all are victims of stereotypical gender roles.

4. Geeta Seshu

Main highlights of her talk were as follows:



- *Relationship between media and women
- *Women being portrayed as objects by the media
- *Missing stories that are not covered by the media
- *Gender media monitoring project hardly any story of violence during the lockdown
- *Situation of women workers are not tackled well by the media.
- *Many women health workers were transported through various means and many domestic workers lost their livelihood.
- *Many students had to dropout as online classes were difficult were attend to.
- *very disproportionate issues of women as audience deal with the media
- *She talks about invisibilisation as we fail to look at how media is structured today
- *lack of gender issues coverage by the media
- *any kind of attempt to regulate policy and question policy is something that needs to be encouraged.
- *She says that all of us are dependent for communication through online modes. The manner in which these online media is controlled has a lack of power in such agencies.
- *Reflection of mainstream media has given up its assigned role of its watchdog to bring about public awareness
- * Exercising control over the media can be helpful

Dr Triveni Goswami Mathur then concludes the session by stating that, "Role and responsibility lies on us and our actions of what we do so that our voices are heard. Unless the media comes out of its shackles, we have long battles to fight with."



The session commenced with the resource person briefing the participants on the varied concepts relating to Mutual Funds like types of Mutual Fund schemes, Units, Net Asset Value (NAV), Systematic Investment Plan (SIP) and its formula, Systematic Transfer Plan (STP), Systematic Withdrawal Plan (SWP), Entry and Exit Load, computation of Short Term and Long Term Capital Gains Tax, and the benefits of investing in Mutual Funds.

Report on Guest Lecture -Skill Building and Self Employment through Application of Costing Techniques in Bakery Segment

The Department of Accountancy organized a guest lecture 01st March 2021 for SY and TY Costing students to understand the application of costing techniques and cost analysis. The session was conducted by Ms.Monica Gilbi, proprietor of Father's Kitchen since 2011 on zoom platform. A total of 66 students attended the session.

The speaker explained the ingredients in quantity and quality followed by a cost analysis of the same. She also updated the students how they could control cost by bulk buying if they want to bake products at commercial level.

The session included a live demonstration of preparation of two products viz. Anzac Cookies and Chocolate Fudge.

This skill building session enabled the students to know preparation of Cost Sheet for Bakery Products- record direct and indirect costs and calculate selling price in different portion sizes of a product. The students got an inspiration towards creating self- employment through hobbies.



Workshop on - "Exploring Opportunities in Personal Financial Planning"

The Department of Business Economics and Banking organised a three day workshop from 24th February to 26th February 2021 on "Exploring Opportunities in Personal Financial Planning" for the final year students specializing in Banking and Finance. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Himanshu Mayne, CFPcm, Founder and CEO of Infinite Financial Academy and CFO, Infinite Financial Planners.

The first day commenced with a brief introduction of the College by Dr. Shalini Iyer, HoD, followed by the rationale of the workshop by Dr. Arwah Madan and a brief introduction of the speaker by Dr. Meenakshi Wagh. Mr. Mayne introduced some significant terms in the financial markets like types of stocks, buy, sell and hold strategies, top down and bottom up approach, value investing, essential for investment decision making. The students were also briefed on calculating and analyzing Ratios, Financials, DDM (Dividend discount models) and Technical Analysis, as well as the indicators of profitability like Return on Equity (ROE) versus Return on Capital Employed (ROCE) with reference to a few companies listed on the major Indian stock exchanges. Mr. Mayne then dealt with the two important components of Personal financial Planning – Budgeting, including emergency fund and loan management essential to avoid a debt trap and to ensure a good CIBIL score. The significance of understanding behavioural finance while making a financial plan was also highlighted.

The highlight of the second day of the workshop was discussion on real life financial plans to understand the concept of reshuffling of the plan to suit the needs and achieve the financial goals of the client in the given timeline. The six step process of preparing a client's financial plan and the significance of collecting the client's accurate information through a questionnaire was also discussed.

The final day of the workshop covered career opportunities in Personal Financial Planning. Highlighting CFP as a growing career option at the national and international level, the speaker briefed the participants on the syllabus of Certified Financial Planning (CFP), the fee structure,



WEBINAR ON EFFECTS OF COVID-19 ON FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF AN NGO (IN ASSSOCIATION WITH PRAYAAS CORPS)

St. Mira's College in association with Prayaas Corps organized a Webinar on Effects of Covid-19 Pandemic on finances of an NGO. The main theme of the Webinar was to enlighten the students about the financial management of an NGO during the pandemic. The webinar also aimed to equip the students with an understanding of the tough times and challenges being faced by NGOs who have been reaching out to the needy and deprived during the pandemic.

For an NGO, the primary task is to work towards social service and not financial management. But unless, the finances are sorted, the objectives cannot be achieved. So equally imperative is the recognition of the significance of financial management for an NGO. NGOs work tirelessly towards implementing projects that cater to the needs of the deprived people and in this process find it difficult to pay enough attention to financial control. This may lead to vulnerability over the financial matters. The webinar was helpful in giving insights into the effects of Covid-19 on the actual funds management by an NGO Prayaas Corps.

Mr. Jaspal Godara, the founder and CEO of Prayaas Corps, provided rich insights into the topic. He dwelt upon the sources of finance during the pre Covid-19 situation and the post Covid-19 situation. Due to the drop in the external contributions post covid-19, Prayaas Corps has to rely mainly on the internal sources viz. contributions by the members and the amounts generated from different activities carried out by them. The focus of the NGO has shifted from 'expanding the reach' to 'surviving economically' as opined by Mr. Godara.



PG seminar is an annual feature of the department of Economics at ST. Mira's College for Girls, Pune. Every year we choose a contemporary theme that offers a forum for discussion and an opportunity for the students to interact with the experts in the field. This year the seminar theme was "Revisiting SDGs in the Context of the Pandemic " in the light of the destruction and challenges posed by the Covid 19 Pandemic globally. SDGs(Sustainable Development Goals) is a charter of 17 development goals encompassing socio economic and environmental sustainability.

The seminar began with a welcome speech by Vice Principal Dr. Shalinilyer.

On Day 1-5th March - In the first session, the resource person Prof. Swati Vaidya addressed the Goal 8 of SDGs i.e the goal of productive employment and decent work. She ably addressed the critical challenge of generating gainful employment and achieving decent work conditions in India in the Covid situation. She touched upon various topics such as large scale labour migration, issue of women workers, online work and related decent work deficits.

In the second session, Prof. Renu Jogdand, presented the challenge of attaining Goal 2 – Zero Hunger. Her presentation on the Pandemic eating into our Hunger Goals was very well presented and equally well received. Using a case study approach, Prof. Renu highlighted the fact that the challenge of hunger is not limited to developing and poor countries, but it has manifested in the developed countries like USA too.

On Day 2-6th March- The first session was about Goal 5- Gender Equality ably addressed by Prof. Arundhati Agt. She presented powerful and structured data on Gender inequalities in income, employment and health. Using various data bases and research studies she effectively put forth the argument that women, who are already a disadvantaged social group, have experienced disproportionate disadvantage due to the pandemic which include worsening gender pay gap, increasing gender violence and more adverse health and poverty outcomes.

In the second session, Prof. Saili Belsare discussed the challenges of health care in the context of Goal 3- Good Health for all. She explained that the goal of good health is a multifaced goal including MaternalMortality goals, Infant Mortalitygoals, freedom from addiction etc. She touched upon various aspects of the health care challenge in India including paucity of funds for other diseases due to covid related public health expenditure, approach towards medical education and ethics in health care. She presented a Tamil Nadu model of healthcare which has been successful in the context of public healthcare.

The seminar summary was presented by Dr. Meenal Sumant. Dr. Soniya Chavan presented vote of thanks as a conclusion to the seminar.

The seminar was coordinated by Dr. Manisha Pimpalkhare.
