Emotional: Worried about not giving consistent performance in the academics compared to previous semester.

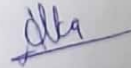
Future Plans: Students discussed their future plans about developing projects and other activities.

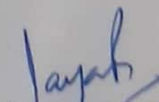
2. Facilitator's response and suggestions:
