2. Facilitator's response and suggestions:

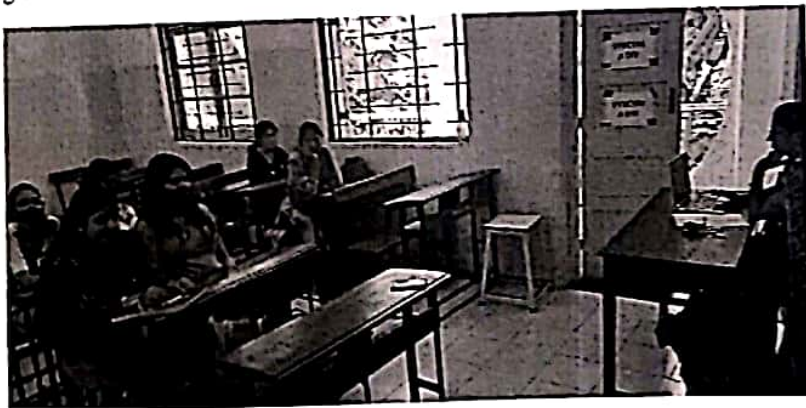
Opening a safe space to talk, identifying things that can be easily changed and controlled in their environment. time management techniques and suggestions to meet college counsellor for the emotional concerns.

2. Facilitator's response and suggestions:

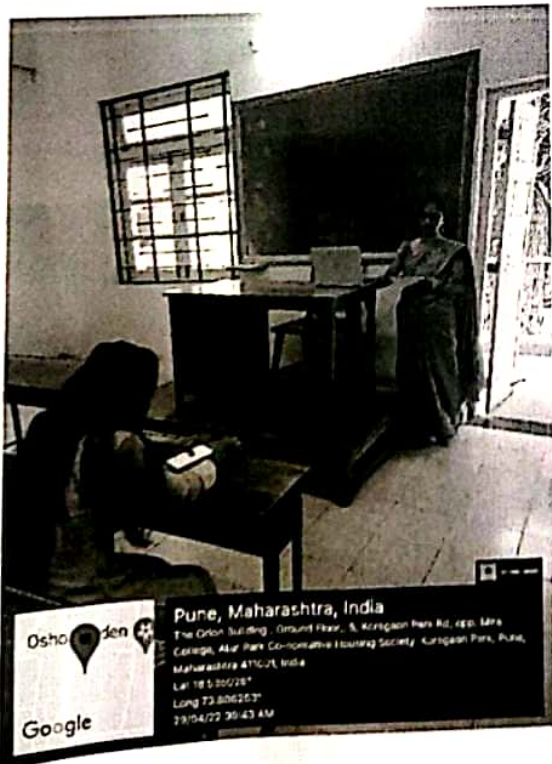
