A Report
On
Credit Course in Research Methodology

Asst. Prof. Rajni Singh conceptualized and coordinated a credit course on Research Methodology under the aegis of Department of Business Studies for final year students of B.Com, B.A (Eco) and M.A (Eco). The course was conducted for 30 hours that amounts to 2 credits. Course fee charged from student was Rs. 1000/-. Remuneration to be paid to Internal and External course instructor were Rs. 300/- and 500/- Lecture respectively.

The primary objective to float the course was to acquaint students with the basic concepts of Research Methodology and to enhance capabilities of students to conduct the research in the field of business and social sciences.

30 students were shortlisted for the course based on the application received. The course was handled by Asst. Prof. Rajni Singh as internal instructor and Asst. Prof. Manjusha Kulkarni as external instructor. During the course students were provide internships with Eventomania- an Event Management Company, Dominos and Healthy Salad – an online Salad Business. The students were evaluated for 50 Marks through a research report, internship report, and viva-voce. Out of 30, 26 students successfully completed the course and 4 students dropped out.

Stock MIND Seminar

A seminar, StockMIND — Season 7, was conducted for SYBBA and TYBBA students on the 28th November 2018. Stock MIND is an annual, nationwide virtual stock market competition for college students, which is in its 7th season. Students from each college compete for 7 market days and the topper forming student represents his/her college at the national level. Several prizes are awarded and all participants receive a participation certificate. StockMIND is an interesting & fun event to learn about the stock market and investing skills.

The speaker, Mr. Nihal Khan, Senior Regional Manager – ICICI Securities Ltd., taught the students about the stock market, the different stock exchanges and the two main stock exchanges of India namely National Stock Exchange and Bombay Stock Exchange. The students were also given an insight into the different types of sectors of the economy and how the different seasons and festivals affect the stocks of different sectors.

The most interesting part of the seminar was the demonstration of trading in equities. He also explained various aspects like why the starting bell of the market floor is very important and how even a paisa matters to trader while buying or selling his equity. He told the students about the different options for trading i.e. Cash Buy, Cash Sale, Margin Buy, Margin Sale.

It was an extremely practical seminar where the students learnt something new. It received a good response from the students where they learned the basics of investing and that investing in equities is not only for the present but for future generations too.

As a part of the NSE Investor Fair, Pune 2019, a pre-event was organised by the National Stock Exchange (NSE) in different colleges in Pune comprising of a presentation on Financial Planning, along with a quiz and an essay writing competition.

Abstract:

An economy is considered to have been going through a slowdown if and when a situation arises where GDP slows and grows in a pace less than that of normal pace, though, it doesn't decline. Therefore, slowdown is not a synonym of recession.

The Indian economy has hit a rough patch and the conspicuous slowdown in every sector is talk of the town. The trajectory of the slowdown is seen through a flow of events - huge debts and failure of corporations, fall in private consumption expenditure, a free in investment recorded besides the NPAs of public sector banks along with the effects of GST implementation, demonetization repercussions, etc. India's GDP growth was at its slowest rate in the last 6 years and slipped to 4.5 percent in the second quarter of FY20.

The paper focuses on the causes and effects of the current slowdown on the Industrial Sector in India. Available research suggests that the economic slowdown is likely to have resulted in large numbers of repercussions on the Industrial sector, in turn adversely affecting the economy of the country as a whole.



Report on encouragement to advance learners through participation in Intercollegiate Moot Court Competition

Two teams from our college participated in the event, each having 3 members- 2 speakers and 1 researcher.

Before the event, they were provided with the moot case. They had to submit two Memorials- one on behalf the Appellant and the other for the Respondent. The students actually experience the role of an Advocate for the few days while preparing and presenting their case.

The preparation of memorials followed by presenting arguments in 'Trials' in front of the panel of Judges required the students to put in tremendous amount of hard work and time.

The judges probed their knowledge of the case facts and presence of mind. The unpredictable elements introduced by the panel of judges tested their spontaneity, alertness, and clarity.

The students experienced - "anything you say can and will be held against you" and being consistent is the most crucial aspect of mooting.

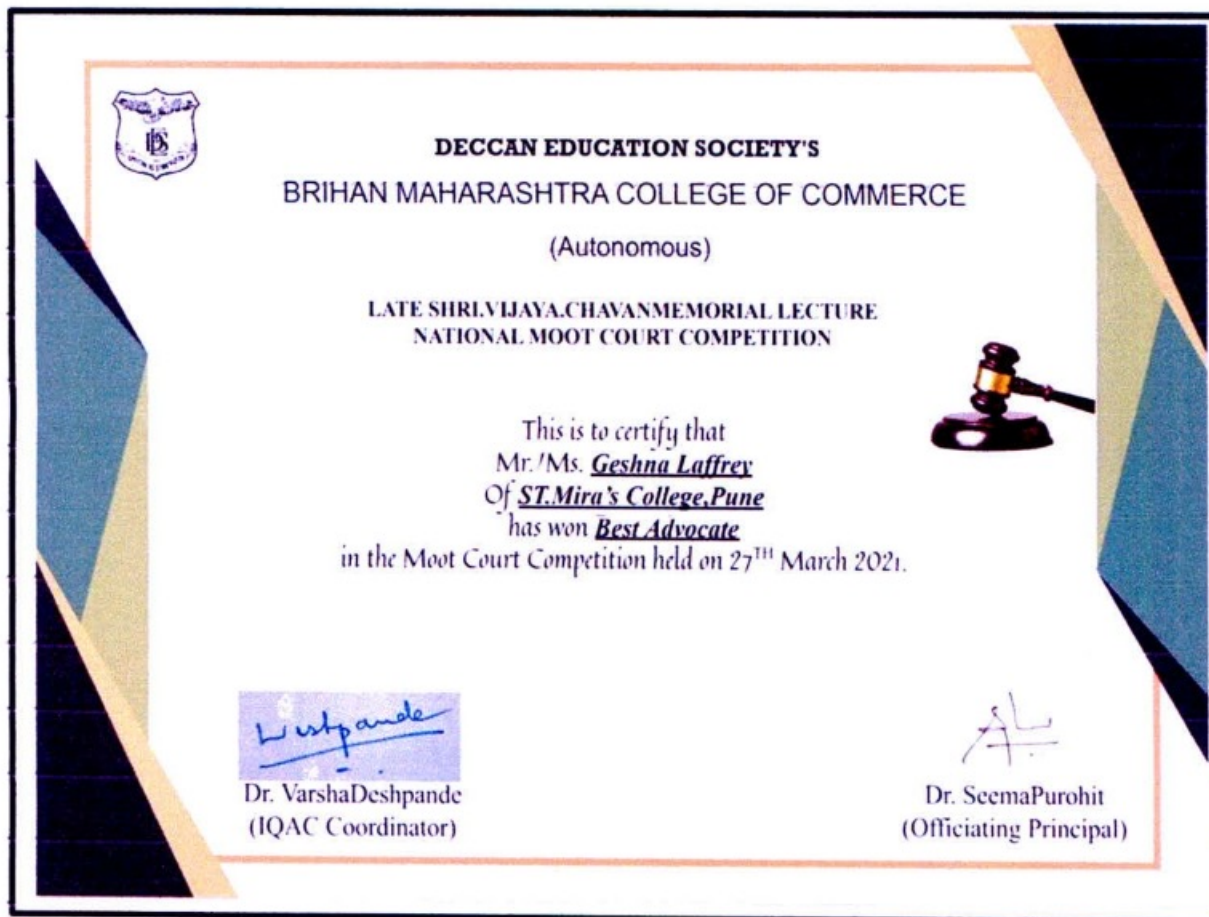

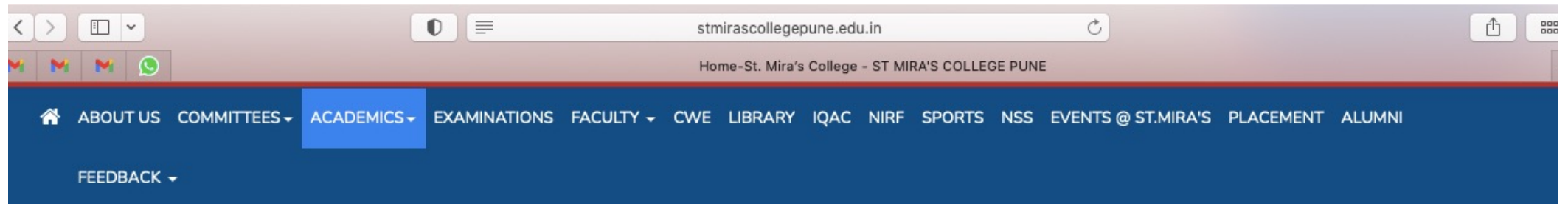

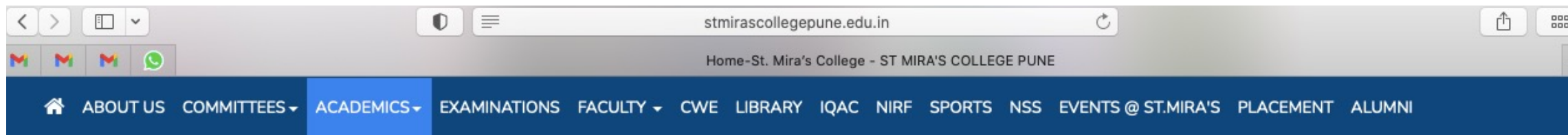
About

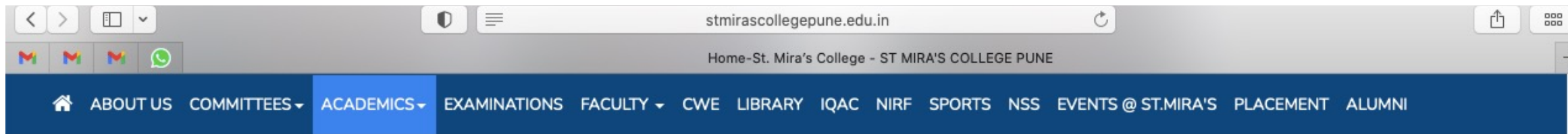
Dr. Kelly Aliano from the Art History Department, LaGuardia Community College, New York, Dr Yan Yang from Burroughs Community College, New York and Dr SnoberSataravala, Department of English St Mira's College for Girls collaborated on the course MILE: Art and Inequality. The course consisted of 4 synchronous lectures conducted every Saturday. The first lecture was conducted by Dr Yan Yang who addressed the theme exploring the European Renaissance focussing on the Mona Lisa. She then discussed the lesser-known Japanese work of art The Tales of Genji. In the second synchronous session Prof Radhika Seshan lectured the students on Mughal paintings. She elaborated on the use of colour, the subjects of the paintings and the division of the canvas linking it to the theme art and inequality. The next lecture was by an artist Mena Malgonkar who shared her aesthetic approach and understanding of modern Indian art. The last lecture was by Dr Kelly Aliano who spoke on Modernism and Dadaism. The students were divided into groups and collaborated on their assignments. They reinterpreted works of art, made 2 minute videos on what they learnt and wrote collaborative commentary on art. The digital platform used was SLACK.

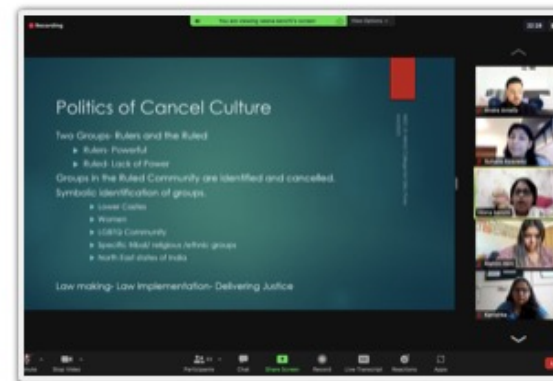
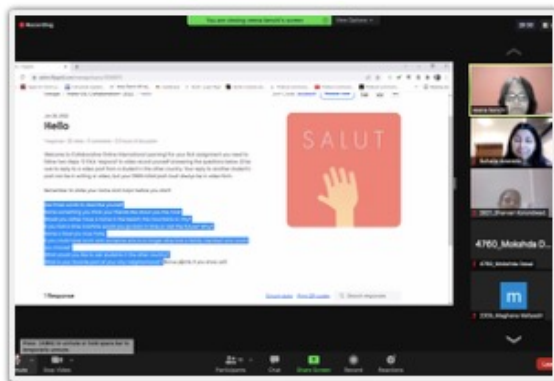

The Department of English and the Department of Politics and Public Administration, St Mira's College for Girls, Pune and the Department of Criminal Justice, LaGuardia Community College collaborated together on an interdisciplinary MILE project called "Angels and Demons: Cancel Culture" The course revolved around the theme "Cancel Culture" and the glorification or demonisation of people on the basis of this concept. In keeping with the theme, the course followed the standard format of students introducing themselves on FlipGrid through ice-breaker videos and posting stories about themselves. Students followed the self-paced course to explore Cancel Culture within the domains of Criminal Justice, Politics and Literature. Four online synchronous sessions were conducted by the faculty members Andre Anteliz, Veena Kenchi and Suhaile Azavedo. 41 students from both the colleges participated in the sessions. The outcome of these sessions was a collaborative project undertaken by the students in mixed groups on the various incidents of Cancel Culture globally. The students studied individual cases and offered a comparative analysis of the ways in which people were glorified and demonised.

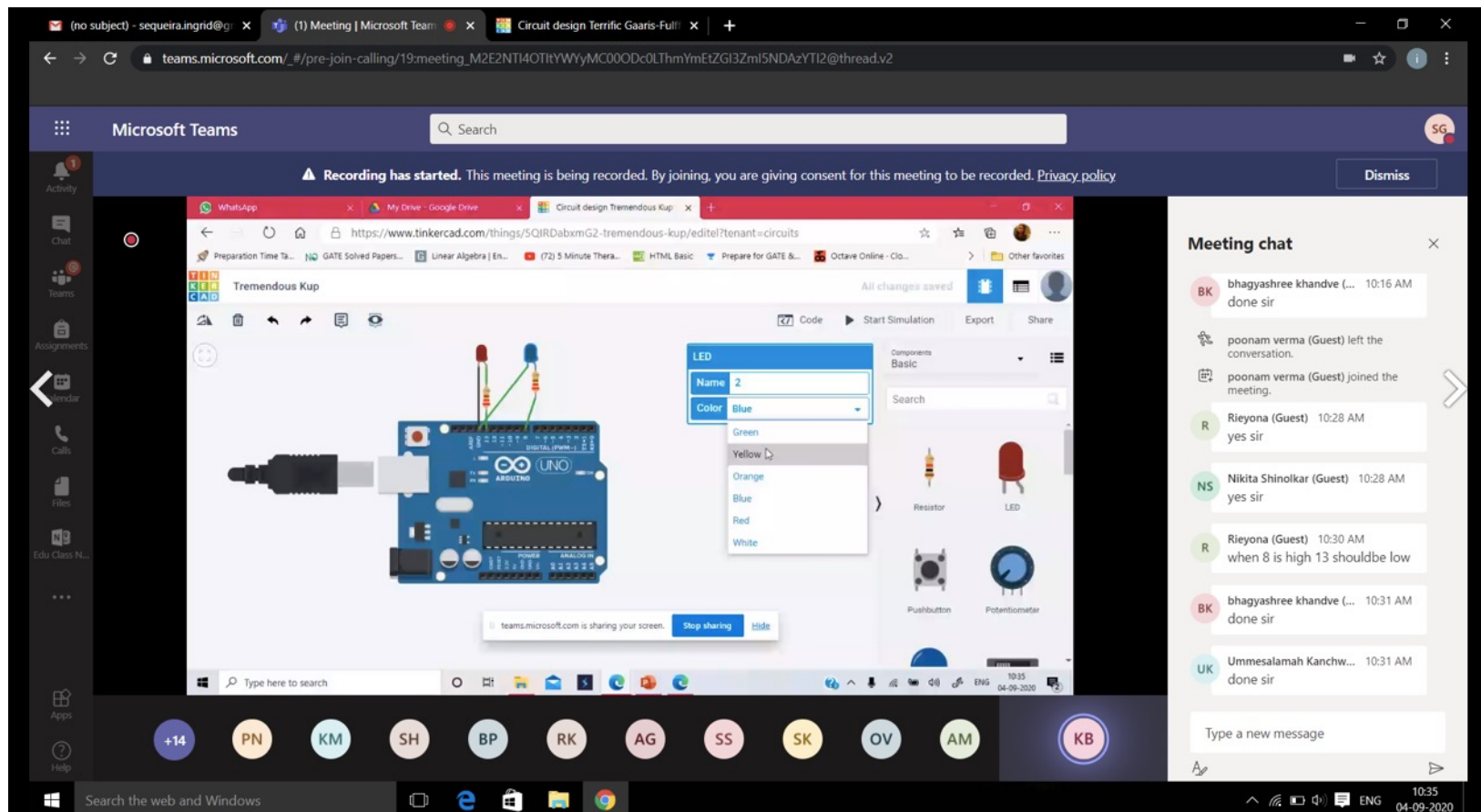

Virtual Skill-based Arduino Uno Workshop

Date: 4 sept -18 sept 2020

The Electronics Department - BSc Computer Science of St Mira's College for Girls in collaboration with 'Mechatron Robotics' organised a 5-day virtual workshop for the students on 'Arduino and its application with Sensors' from 4th to 18th September 2020 for S.Y.B.Sc (CS) students.

The main objective of this workshop was to familiarise the students with Arduino and how it can be interfaced with sensors for the application of a smart system, smart home, or for IoT purposes. The trainers for this workshop were Ms. Karmaan Bhatia and Mr. Omkar Varma, who guided the students very patiently in the online mode. The workshop covered the following points:

Day 1 covered the introduction to microprocessors and microcontrollers; the basics of Arduino, pin configuration and connections and LED interfacing with Arduino. Day 2 covered the basics of a breadboard and its connections, basics of PWM, the fading effect of LED, application of push-button and introduction to sensors and components in tinkercad. Day 3 covered interfacing temperature sensor TMP 36 and LEDs using Arduino UNO. Day 4 topics were interfacing the ultrasonic sensor with LEDs and buzzer using Arduino UNO, interfacing 7-segment display with Arduino UNO and interfacing LCD with Arduino UNO. Day 5 topics were interfacing gas sensors and LEDs using Arduino UNO, interfacing PIR sensor and LEDs using Arduino UNO and interfacing tilt sensor and LED using Arduino UNO. 22 students from S.Y.B.Sc. (CS) participated in the workshop which was spread over five sessions. By the end of the workshop, the students were not only familiar with the basics of Arduino and its application with sensor but were also able to construct moderate level projects.
