Discussion.

Research Requirements under CAS

As per the New CAS requirement (GR Date March 8th, 2019), it is no longer mandatory to have publication of research papers to qualify for promotion to the next level. Earlier, the faculty had to have two research publication in the assessment period.

The Principal Incharge pointing out to the new requirement said that it would have an impact on the research component of the Institution as a whole. The faculty may not take on publications as it is no longer a requirement for promotions.

All members of the Research Committee were of the opinion that it would further have its implication on the College performance at both NAAC as well as NIRF.

There was consensus among the members that a strong appeal to be made to all the faculty (aided as well as un-aided section) to take on research publications and research projects and work towards the improving the Research score of the College at NAAC and NIRF.

The members also agreed that though one research publication in approved journals is already made mandatory since 2020, there is need for the faculty to follow the same in letter and spirit.

The Principal Incharge stated that she would call for an all faculty meeting to once again make an appeal for everyone to contribute; however, strong action may be required if there is not marked improvement seen in the research score by the end of the year 2021.

While the members agreed that there is a rise in the number of initiatives and activities taken up at the college and departmental level, it is necessary that the faculty also contributes to the research quotient of the college.

Resolution:

3. Intensive Workshops for Faculty on Regular Basis for Desired Outcomes

The Committee agreed that there is a need for intensive workshops to initiate faculty members to publish a paper. Though many faculties actively participated in many workshops held during the period of lockdown and after, however, the need is for more practical workshop leading to definite outcome- i.e. a publication each by the faculty who have not published or are struggling though the same.

It would require hand-holding and monitoring of the same in separate groups. The Research Committee members to contribute at the workshop on various subject areas. Various topics to be suggested so that an intensive workshop can be planned for a period of six months.

Resolution

- A workshop to be planned soon once a meeting is held with all faculty members to understand their research difficulties as well as needs.
- A questionnaire would be circulated to understand the difficulties and needs of the faculty members on the research aspect.

Minutes -

Dr. Vaishali Diwakar welcomed the committee members and explained the purpose of the meeting. She explained that the research activity carries 70 points out of the total 150 points of the third criteria. She explained the key indicators of the criterion. The sub-committee discussed the resources for research grants. It was pointed out that the mainstream research funding agencies give grants only to university approved teachers. Therefore in the meeting it was decided to explore funding agencies for non grant faculty members.

Dr. Diwakar disseminated the details of the IQAC committee meeting and communicated the decision that every department has to submit one research project every year and every faculty to publish one research paper in the peer reviewed journal. The committee discussed the difficulties in getting resources for doing research. Following measures are suggested and unanimously agreed upon in the meeting.

- 1. Institutional tie ups for sharing of resources at institutional level especially costly equipments and
- 2. More private funding agencies to be explored.
- 3. The committee will keep posted each other regarding new research opportunities and will review the progress by February first week.

4. The sub-committee will meet on 16th of every month to review its work.
