




KAR SEVA- AT SADHU VASWANI MISSION




Report- Tree Plantation- 4th July 2017

SURGICAL STRIKE DAY - 29th September 2018








Bal Mela- 11 January 2019

The discussion included Prime Minister Modi discussing stress management, time management which will help students to develop and take decisions for their future.






He also urged students to build relations with their parents, understand them, introduce them to new technology and conversations should flow in the household. And parents should develop their relations




