Report on Alumni Activities 2021-2022

She shared her rich experience at the college with the present students and motivated them to register with the Alumni Association as members. St. Mira's College Alumni Association oriented the newly inducted First Years in Student Induction Programme on 29-09-21. The students came to know about the different activities carried out by the Association over the years. Alumna Dr.Soniya Chavan, Former HOD Economics and CoE, shared her experience at St. Mira's. Alumna turned Faculty members Ms. Elizabeth Kanade, Ms. Deepanjali Mazumdar, Ms. Jyoti Chintan expressed their heartfelt gratitude towards the college as they recollected sweet memories from their college days.

Pariche demonstrated the correct way to care for hair and suggested effective tips and products that one could use to get that luscious mane they have always dreamed of. Ms. Rupal Gesota, Secretary, Alumni Association graced the first day of the session and lauded the initiative. Day 2 of the session was conducted by Pariche Mehta and Divya Kukreja who demonstrated an "Office and Professional" makeup and hairstyle look on the Priyanka. Day 3 of the session involved the extremely talented alumnae, creating and demonstrating a traditional makeup and hairstyle look on model Saloni Gangani of TYBBA. Both the alumnae were extremely kind and forthcoming in answering the numerous questions posed by the attentive and enthusiastic audience throughout the 3 days. The session was concluded on a positive note of students asking for Courses, Internship and skill to liason with clients. work. The Certificates of Appreciation were presented virtually to Pariche Mehta and Divya Kukreja. Mrs. Gauri Mhalgi, treasurer graced the last days session and requested the alumnae to take up more such initiatives and help in strengthening the Alumni Association further.

As a way of accelerating the national drive for vaccination in the Covid -19 pandemic, the St Mira's College Alumni Association conducted a Two Days Vaccination Drive in association with Pune Municipal Corporation on 10th and 11th February 2022. The Vaccination camp was organized in college campus from 11 am onwards for the students of St. Mira's College aged between 15 to 18 years old. In 2 days of the vaccination programme, a total of 238 beneficiaries availed of this facility. Students from Arts, Commerce and Science streams were vaccinated with first or second dose of Covaxin. Many faculty members of the college and their family members also took the vaccines under Staff Welfare initiative. The College office provided able support with sevikas for coordination and refreshments for the medical team. The event commenced on 10th February at 11 am in the presence of Principal-In-Charge Dr Jaya Rajgopalan, Vice Principals Dr Shalini Iyer and Mrs Suvarna Deolankar. One of the college alumna, Mrs Prachi Alhat, a PMC Corporator, was also present at the beginning who had earlier helped in initiating the vaccination drive in the college. The entire event was monitored and handled by the Alumni Association Secretary Ms Rupal Gesota with the support of Alumni College Committee Coordinator Dr. Dimple Buche and members Mrs Smita Borkar and Mrs Amrita Basu. To make the entire vaccination process effortless and seamless, the data was collected from students needing vaccination through google forms and were guided on both pre- and post-vaccination requirements. Through this noble initiative, the Alumni Association of College has ensured the progress of education by providing the students and the faculty members with utmost safety measure.
















Interaction with Alumna Ms Sriradha Gupta, 30-10-21_Department of Politics and Public Administration




