The Department of Economics organized an Alumni Interaction on Friday 12, March, 2021 at 12 noon for the benefit of BA and MA Economics students. Our alumnus, Ms Hennashka Israni of BA Economics 2013 batch and MA Economics 2015 batch spoke on progression to Masters' Program, career goals, career path after a major in Economics.

She commenced her talk by talking of the acronym - INDIA which she elaborated as follows:

I - Identification of Skill Sets - Belief in oneself and taking up something which we are passionate about, in order to identify the skills one is good at and can pursue further.

N - Nurturing our skills Sets - Being inquisitive, having an exploratory nature helps keeping the end goal in mind, for which networking with faculty, friends, parents is important.

D - Development - Students should make a Curriculum Vitae or resume), obtain more online course certifications like Microsoft certifications (MS Office), courses in Editing, Interview skills, and the like, take on work from home internships, be involved in humanitarian work like Volunteering, Community Outreach (like suicide prevention work, tree plantation drives).

I - Investment in activities - This was an extension of Development. For those interested in pursuing their Masters, she recommended that they compile their Statement of Purpose (SOP) - so that they could make applications to institutions of higher learning. She reiterated the importance of involvement in volunteering, internships and other community outreach activities as being important inclusions in one's CV. For those interested in working with the United Nations, she made reference to UN websites like unv.org and careers.un.org. She emphasized the importance of starting small in the UN, and revealed that it could be as small as volunteering with the UN by way of translating content into local language for distance education purposes or data analysis, pamphlet making and so on. Learning a foreign/regional language was also an additional competancy which one could imbibe.

A - Action Plan - This included execution of all the prior steps and and attaining one's goal before graduation, involved taking volunteering, internships, and the like seriously. She recommended efficient use of websites like LinkedIn for securing internships, making a CV, making job applications before graduation in order to avoid a time lag between graduation and placement.

Career Options - She touched upon career options open to students of Economics major like teaching, research, policy analysis with think tanks and other organizations like the UN.

FAQs- She went on to answer the students' queries, relating to funding, sponsorship for higher studies abroad, career progression. She shared her contact details and promised to continue mentoring the

Feedback- The alumni interaction was well received by the students of SYBA, TYBA and MA Economics. About 49 students participated in the program. Out of these, 26 students submitted their positive feedback about the session, all stating that the session was "inspiring", "motivational" and
