

THE 55TH A.D. SHROFF MEMORIAL ELOCUTION COMPETITION
FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS OUTSIDE MUMBAI (2019-20)

Objects, rules, regulations, subjects, prizes etc.

1. This Competition is being conducted since 1965 in memory of the late Mr. A.D. Shroff with the object of encouraging college students to think and speak on economic and other subjects, besides enabling them to display their oratory skills.
2. The Competition is open to degree course students only (11th and 12th standard students are not eligible). Participants may speak in English, Hindi or the regional language on ANY ONE of the following subjects:
 - A. QUEST TOWARDS INCLUSIVE GROWTH IN INDIA;
 - B. HEALTH FOR ALL: Reforming National Health Policy;
 - C. ROLE OF A MODEL CITIZEN IN INDIAN DEMOCRACY.
3. Each participant will be allowed to speak for FIVE MINUTES. The participant will state his/her subject before starting to speak. A warning bell will be sounded at end of the fourth minute followed by another at end of the fifth minute. Participants are free to express any views they desire. They may refer to notes for quoting statistics, if any, but should not read from a written text.
4. A panel of judges, appointed by the college, will select the three best speakers on the basis of Contents (60 Marks); Presentation and Elocution (40 Marks). The panel's decision will be final.
5. Prizes: First - Rs.2,500/-; Second - Rs.1,500/-; Third - Rs.1,000/-.
6. Certificates will be given to the best five speakers.
