- 2. The Competition is open to degree course students only (11th and 12th standard students are not eligible). Participants may speak in English, Hindi or the regional language on ANY ONE of the following subjects:

 - B. HEALTH FOR ALL: Reforming National Health Policy;
 - C. ROLE OF A MODEL CITIZEN IN INDIAN DEMOCRACY.
- 5. Each participant will be allowed to speak for FIVE MINUTES. The participant will state his/her subject before starting to speak. A warning bell will be sounded at end of the fourth minute followed by another at end of the fifth minute. Participants are free to express any views they desire. They may refer to notes for quoting statistics, if any, but should not read from a written text.
- 4. A panel of judges, appointed by the college, will select the three best speakers on the basis of Contents (60 Marks); Presentation and Elocution (40 Marks). The panel's decision will be final.
- 5. Prizes: First Rs.2,500/-; Second Rs.1,500/-; Third Rs.1,000/-.
- 6. Certificates will be given to the best five speakers.
