With a focus on academic excellence to ensure quality in all operations, the core team of the IQAC include Dr. Gulshan Gidwani, Principal of the College as the IQAC Chairperson, Dr. Jaya Rajagopalan as the IQAC Coordinator.

This report details the activities/events carried out by the IQAC in accordance with the Plan of Action that had been outlined the previous year.

The academic year 2017-18, witnessed a of plethora of activities that aimed at continuous improvement and promotion of quality culture.






In order to create an environment that promotes and stimulates the spirit of







The college has also signed an MoU with Tata Cosultancy Services for an Academic Interface Programme. The objective of the programme is to make the students corporate ready by training the college faculty and the students in various industry related domains like Banking, Insurance, F & A, etc. and 13other domains.



The Department of Psychology has entered into a collaboration with Zensar Technologies to hone the research acumen of their students; Zensar is helping the students to collate the data that they have obtained during their community visits and qualitatively analyze it.



The Psychology department has also tied up with 'Nayi Disha'- an online information resource platform. The students of St. Mira's will help 'Nayi Disha' to generate the lead data and conduct surveys for creating the directory that supports families of persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD) in the city of Pune.



#### In addition, we have the following quality initiatives

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and the outcome achieved by the end of the year.

- Reviewing and analyzing academic programmes- Feedback from students was assessed
  and analyzed by every HOD, Analysis of the Feed Back for the year 2017-2018 showed
  an overall high satisfaction with the course content of every subject, Syllabus for the T.Y.
  B.A. and the T.Y.B. Com classes was revised, while the new autonomous syllabus for the
  T.Y.BBA, T.Y. BCA, and T.Y.B.Sc. (Computer Science) was framed.
- Introduction of newAdditional Credit Courses- Some inter disciplinary short term extra
  credit courses to make ourstudents employable in fields other than in pure academics were
  conducted. These courses were open to all students of every discipline.
- Ensuring the quality of the administrative units of the College- Software 'Vriddhi' for admissions and online filling of examination formsimplemented, All documents in the administrative unit have been digitized to ensure, quick access to information and for preservation of important documents.
- Initiating ICT Innovations and increasing the activities of the GreenClub- A number of
  indigenous software's have been developed by the faculty of the Computer Science
  department to improve the academic and the administrative efficiency of the college.
- Revisiting the marking scheme decided upon for self-appraisal (API scores) and promotion through Career AdvancementSchemes of UGC; Guiding teachersfor the same-IQAC has interpreted the intricacies of the new appraisal system for college teachers as per UGC regulations (2010) and has guided teachers with respect to the marking scheme of the 3 categories of API. This yearthe IQAC revisited the marking scheme and updated it as per suggestionsreceived. Two teachers were promoted this year according to the Career Advancement Scheme.
- Implementing some important Examination Reforms- The Examination Cell has
  successfully used two indigenouslydevised software's the Question Paper Picker and the
  Examination Timetable Scheduler during the conduct of the examinations. These
  software's have facilitated the processes in the examinationcell and increased the
  confidentiality of the examination process. Use of The Flexi Test generator and the
  advanced online examsoftware to convenience the Internal Testing System, Alternate day
  exams instead of extended study leave

#### • Extra Credit Course:

In order to enhance student competencies, their employment opportunities and add value to their academic programmes we conducted a number of short-term extra credit courses.


A one credit course in Digital Marketing and Image Management and a two-credit course in GBS Certification was coordinated by the BBA department.

The centre organised an interaction with an agri-horticultural entrepreneur, a Career Guidance Lecture by TIME and a highly interactive and informative Orientation session on setting up an Incubation Centre in our college in collaboration with TISS, Mumbai.



The CWE wing of the college hosted the grand gala annual fest 'Mira Bazaar' to primarily inculcate and hone the multiple skills of research, costing, production, promotion and customer service amongst girl students across all faculties. 50 Stalls of foodstuff, handmade jewellery, clothes, accessories, candles, greeting cards, cosmetics, games, health products, mehendi, tattoo art etc. were put up. As a part of social entrepreneurship outreach, the green club hosted two stalls in Mira Bazaar and the proceeds from the sale of these items were used for green initiatives of the college.


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


#### · Value Based Education, Art of Living & Sanctuary






#### • EXTENSION ACTIVITIES


This year the college has focused on year-long activities with various organisation in order to bring about a more sustained and hence meaningful impact to their lives.






**Research Project:** In collaboration with AIDWA, TY sociology students conducted a survey on "The Impact of Television Serials on Working Class Women".

Students who have offered Education as a subject visit the Dhanwantri School, Ganj Peth, every week and engage the young school children in craft, drawing, brain games and painting.






#### SPORTS:
