The Idol-making activity began with a humble Sanctuary talk in 2016, where a simple YouTube video on working with *shaadumatti* was screened in the college Sanctuary. From then on, the activity has become a beloved yearly tradition for Green Club members as well as the college. On Saturday, 1st September, 2018, enthusiastic students and faculty participated in the Ganpati idol making activity annually conducted by the Green Club. Students, led by Shivani, Sumedha and Suman, created the eco-friendly idol and *mooshak* (Bappa's charioteer) from 4 kgs of '*shaadumatti*' (river bed clay). 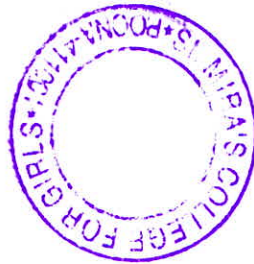
