AUTONOMOUS PATTERN OF ST. MIRA'S COLLEGE
RULES OF EQUIVALENCE
(For Degree Courses of B.A., B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) AND BSC)

Extent and Application of Rules of Equivalence:

The Rules of Equivalence given herein shall be applicable to the students admitted, from the previous curriculum of SMC to the current curriculum of SMC; and to the students admitted from University affiliated colleges/autonomous colleges to the current curriculum of SMC, in the academic year 2021-22 and thereafter.

The students, from University affiliated colleges/Autonomous colleges, desirous of seeking admission to Sem III in autonomous pattern of the college shall register for the courses in the said semester.

In addition, the student also has to register and pass the mandatory add on courses of SMC and mandatory add on courses as per the requirement of the parent university if any, introduced in the previous semesters for which equivalence is being considered.


When a student switches over from university affiliated colleges/autonomous colleges to autonomous pattern of SMC, student shall be presumed to have earned credits of all courses offered in previous semesters of that program in university affiliated colleges/autonomous colleges. The student needs to appear for the non-equivalent courses as per SMC equivalence norms.

General Rules of Equivalence:

(1) The College decided to close the previous curriculum of degree Courses of B.A., B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) and Bsc Computer Science, except the immediate preceding curriculum, for equivalence purpose.

(2) A student from Degree Courses of B.A., B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) and Bsc Computer Science under previous curriculum, desiring and qualified to take admission as per the rules of equivalence will be permitted to take admission to the next class, if the equivalence norms are fulfilled.




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(3) If a student from Degree Courses of B.A., B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) and Bsc Computer Science under the previous curriculum is admitted to Degree Courses of B.A., B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) and Bsc Computer Science under the current curriculum, she shall be governed by the Rules of the Revised Curriculum.

Rules of Equivalence for BBA(CA):

A) (If the student is from St. Mira's College)

1) The student shall be eligible for admission under the Equivalence scheme to the next class if:

a) The student has cleared all the subjects of the previous class.

OR

b) The student has eligibility to go to the next class as per the norms of Yet to Clear ATKT.

2) The student shall be eligible for admission under the Equivalence scheme for the TY class, if the student has cleared all the subjects and add on courses of the First Year.

3) A student from a Degree Course of BBA(CA) under the previous curriculum admitted to the Degree Course of BBA(CA) under the revised curriculum shall be required to pass in mandatory add on courses and non-equivalent subjects, as given in the table below. The examination method and passing criteria for add on courses and non-equivalent subjects shall be as per the revised curriculum.

The student is exempted from passing equivalent subjects, as given in the table below.

4) A student from Degree Course of BBA (CA) under the previous curriculum admitted in Degree Course of BBA(CA) under Revised Curriculum by applying ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) Rules shall be required to pass in the subject or subjects in which she has failed or remained absent. The examination method and passing criteria for such subject or subjects shall be as per the previous pattern.

5) The non-equivalent subjects required to pass as shown in column (4) of the above Table shall not be taken into account while applying the ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) Rules. A student needs to appear and pass in such non-equivalent subjects and ATKT subjects as per the schedule of examination. The marks obtained in non-equivalent subjects and ATKT subjects shall be taken into account while computing percentages of marks and for award of degree.

6) A student from Degree Course of BBA (CA) under the previous curriculum admitted in Degree Course of BBA(CA) under Revised Curriculum shall be exempted from appearing and passing the equivalent subjects as shown in column (5) of above Table.


B) If the student is from University affiliated college/Autonomous College

- 1) The student shall be eligible for admission under the Equivalence scheme to BBA(CA) Sem III if the student has cleared all the subjects of the previous class in the university affiliated college/autonomous college.
- 2) The student shall not be considered eligible for admission under the Equivalence scheme to BBA(CA) Sem III, if the student is having more than 50% non-equivalent subjects per semester.
- 3) A student from a Degree Course of BBA(CA) from University affiliated college /Autonomous college admitted in Degree Course of BBA(CA) under the Revised Curriculum shall be required to pass in minimum 1 subject and maximum 3 subjects of a semester with different titles of the First year and all the add on courses of the First Year as per the stream/parent university.
